When we ask a question, we've researched it. The answer we have is the correct answer. Don't think so? The decision of the judges will be final and will not be subject to change. So there.

Correct spelling on the answer sheets is not required, however, answers must be legible and the judges must be able to easily recognize your answers.

Each team will choose a team name. Be creative.

Each team receives a sheet for your answers at the beginning of each game. The sheet outlines the game and is just used to follow along and keep track of the categories.

There will be 5 rounds with 10 questions per round broken into two halves.

Each question will be worth a stated point amount; you must get the full answer for it to be considered correct.

You will have approximately two minutes from the end of the round to turn in your sheet.

There will be an intermission in between rounds while the answers are scored, use this time for socializing and buying the hosts a drink.

Each team will get one double point sticker that can be used when they choose during the game.

The winner will be the team at the end of the 5 rounds with the most points, there will be a bonus round if a tie occurs.
